



2019 Shell Oiltimers Club Hikes

All day Tuesday hikes are planned for areas generally west of Calgary (see the proposed Hike Schedule below). In this schedule, there are references to guide books, in which descriptions can be found for each given hike. A Master Hiking Map is also available on Page 4 below showing typical hikes possible in each area with guide book references. Many other useful guidebooks are also available from retailers such as Mountain Equipment Co-Op.

With respect to the hikes:

- Participants are suggested to meet at the pre-arranged meeting place shown in the schedules to form car pools, so as to accommodate a departure time of 8:30 AM.
- Unless otherwise indicated, the meeting place will be near the PetroCan station, specifically at the north end of Township Road 245A, immediately west of Highway # 22 and north of Highway # 1, as shown on the Master Hiking Map.
- At the end of the day, car pool passengers are expected to pay car pool drivers a fair share of transportation costs
- Participants must be familiar with and follow safe hiking practices (see Note #1, below). Participants must know the limits of their capabilities, and hike within them.
- Participants with similar capabilities will hike together, in groups, preferably containing four or more adults.
- Participants will assemble at the trail head before each hike to arrange groupings and timing. Participants will research each given hike before attempting it and bring any useful maps, etc.
- Participants who are more knowledgeable of a given hike will assist those who are less knowledgeable.

Oiltimers, friends and family members are welcome to participate in the hikes on the understanding that participants are responsible for themselves and any accompanying minors, and that each participant holds all other participants harmless in respect of any harm or damage, arising from the hikes or associated activities, that may be suffered by them or accompanying minors.

Note 2: This column is not meant to be prescriptive. Passengers should agree with drivers to fairly compensate them for their costs incurred.

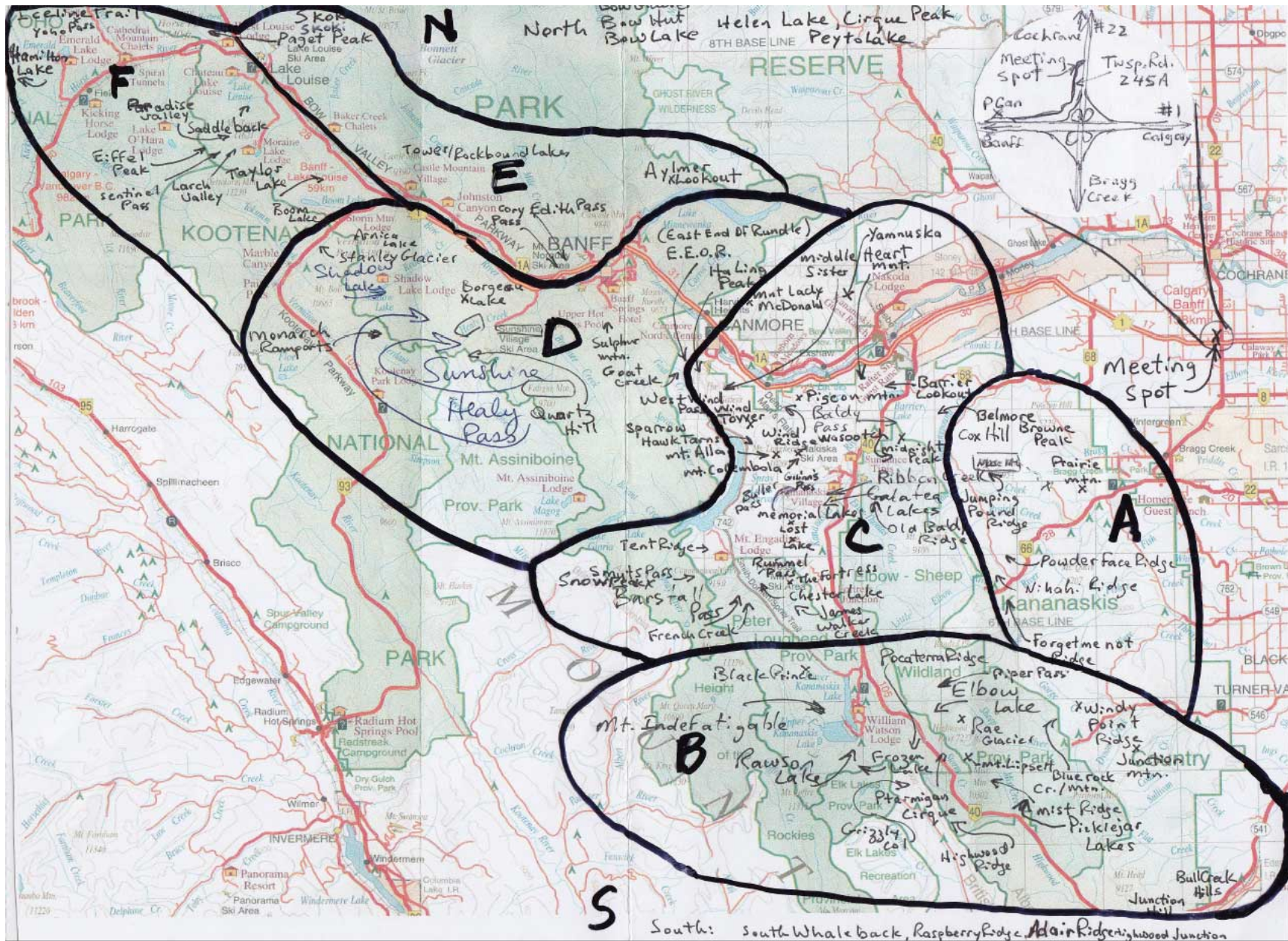
Note 3: The Oiltimers AGM is also scheduled for May 14, 2019 (5:00 PM).
